### **Position purpose**

This is a Journey L

Level Technician position. This position provides manufacturing, repair, testing, trouble shooting of electronic cables and assembly of electronic cabinets in support of the military and commercial tasks.

### **Responsibilities/Duties/Functions/Tasks**

Incumbent performs electronic technician duties assembling, modification, testing, troubleshooting, and repair of electronic components, cables, parts, equipment and systems for both military and commercial products, by applying principles and theories of electronics, electrical circuitry, and electrical testing. Incumbent will work from written or verbal instructions and be able to interpret and work from documentation, drawings, schematics, and

technical data performing testing & evaluation, calibration, and certifications tasks. Incumbent will layout cable assemblies, assemble electronic cabinets, and perform electrical testing of cable, harness, and other automated product testing using a DITMO Wire Analyzer.

Incumbent promotes professionalism and communicates regularly with subordinates and management in completing tasks. Communication can be written or oral, but is clear, accurate and complete.

Incumbent must have the ability to perform duties as assigned with minimal supervision or direction.

### **Qualifications**

Vocational/technical training beyond high school and at least 2 years of job-related experience. Good written communication skills, working knowledge of word processing and integrated software applications, and ability to perform detail-oriented work are required. Ability to become solder certified to J-STD-001. Ability to read/interpret electronic circuitry, plans and layouts and have a comprehensive knowledge and practical understanding of electronic theory. Requires knowledge and operation of electronic equipment including volt/ohm, megohmmeters, and automated test equipment for testing, troubleshoot, and performing acceptance testing of electronic equipment.

### **Special Position Requirements**

Must possess or be able to meet/obtain J-STD-001 solder certification. Must possess the ability to obtain and maintain a US Department of Defense Security Clearance. Position may require limited travel.

### **Preferences**

Experience with operating a DITMO Wire Analyzer or Automated Test Equipment.

### **Work Requirements**

Most tasks are performed in laboratory setting. Safety Glasses may be required for certain task. Some tasks may require lifting up to 50 lbs.
